10th Anniversary Exhibition

Eligibility

- All current and past members are eligible to submit images for consideration for inclusion. Priority will be given to current members.

Submission and Selection

- Members can submit up to five images for consideration by the AHPC Exhibition Committee.
- Members submit their images online and an email will be sent to all members with details.
- Images submitted online must conform to Projected Digital Image (PDI) competition sizing (72 dpi).
- Images can be submitted as portrait, landscape or square orientation.
- Images must not include a border.
- Images must be able to be printed as A4 borderless images or A3 borderless images or square borderless images.
- Images can be submitted for A3 prints however, due to exhibition space constraints, only a small number of images (approx. 6) will be selected by the exhibition committee for this format.
- Closure date for submissions will be 11:59pm 09 June 2021.
- Members will be notified on 14 June 2021 if their images have been selected for inclusion in the exhibition.
- Image selection for inclusion in the exhibition is the responsibility of the AHPC Exhibition Committee however a key objective is to include at least one image from each club member.
- The online submission will provide for three classes with maximum of five images across all classes. There will be an A4 Portrait orientation class (max. 5 images), an A4 Landscape orientation class (max. 5 images) and an A3 Landscape orientation class (max. 1 image).
- The same image can be submitted as both an A4 Landscape and an A3 Landscape for consideration by the AHPC Exhibition Committee.

Printing and Mounting

- Members are responsible for printing their images if selected for inclusion in the exhibition.
- Images are to be printed on A4 paper (A3 paper for a small number of prints). Specialist papers and inks are permitted but images must not be framed or pre-mounted. The paper thickness must not exceed 0.6mm.
- Images must be printed edge to edge without borders.
- The sizing for prints is:
 - A4 Portrait: 210mm wide by 297mm high
 - A4 Landscape: 297mm wide by 210mm high
 - A3 Landscape: 420mm wide by 297mm high
 - Square: Less than or equal to 210mm by 210mm
- Images must be printed from a high-resolution file at 300 dpi.
- Members can forward their high-resolution jpeg files via email to ahpc.competitionsecretary@gmail.com for printing if preferred. The Competition Secretary will coordinate printing with a commercial printer however

the cost of printing is the responsibility of the member. Approximate costs for printing are \$7 for A4 and \$16 for A3.

- The AHPC Exhibition Committee will mount the images on a black matte. The black matte will be supplied by the club and on completion of the exhibition will be provided to the member free of charge and returned to the member with their print.
- The AHPC Exhibition Committee may exclude prints from the exhibition if they do not meet the sizing or resolution criteria.

Exhibition Catalogue

- A catalogue will be created for the exhibition listing the title of each image and name of the photographer.
- Each image will be identified by an image title and the photographers name on the matte.
- Images may be offered for sale. Prices for images will not be advertised but a note will be included in the catalogue stating, "Images may be available for sale please contact the Adelaide Hills Photography Club if you are interested in purchasing any of the exhibited images."
- The catalogue will state that "All images are subject to copyright with the copyright owned by the photographer identified in this catalogue".

Exhibition Layout

- The layout of the exhibition is the responsibility of the AHPC Exhibition Committee.

Key Dates

- May 15 – Image submission opens.
- June 09 – Image submission closes.
- June 14 – Members notified of acceptances.
- July 02 – Members to deliver printed images for mounting.
- July 24 – Exhibition set up (i.e. 'Bump In').
- July 26 – Official Opening.
- August 14 – Exhibition Ends.
- August 14 – Exhibition pack down (i.e. 'Bump Out').
- August 25 – Mounted images returned to members (Club meeting night).
