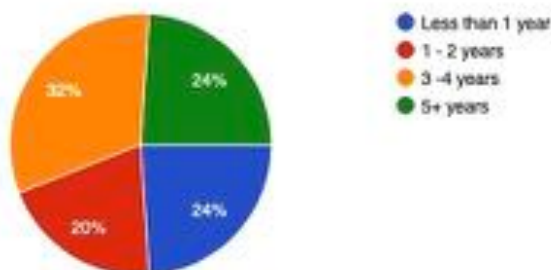
## 2019 Survey & 2020 Program

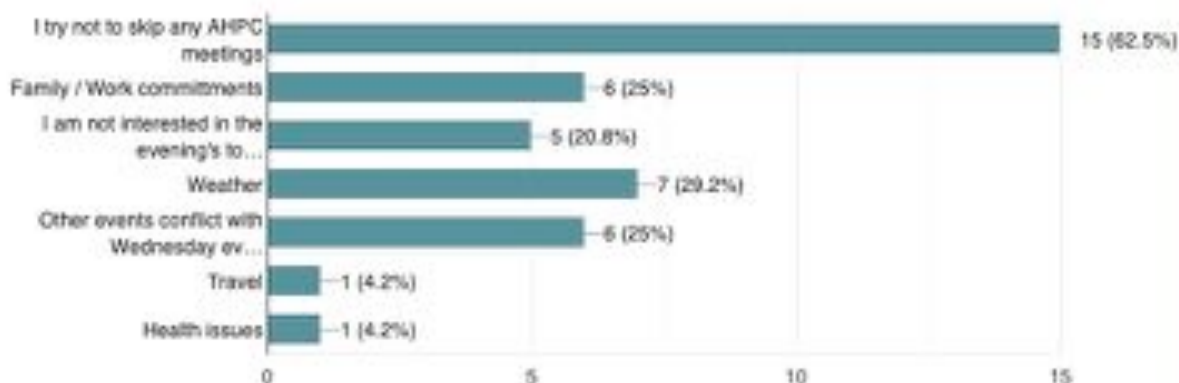
### How long have you been a AHPC member?

25 responses



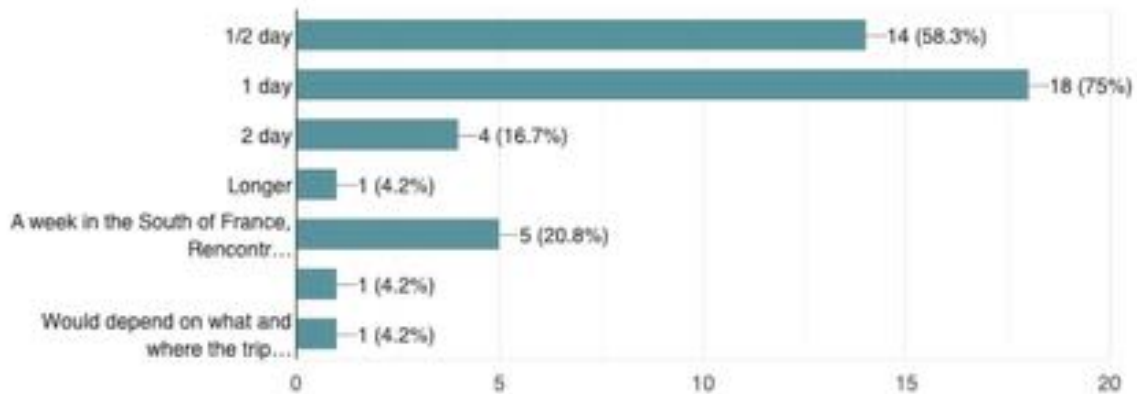
### What are the main reasons you may not attend all AHPC Meetings? (Please tick any that apply)

24 responses



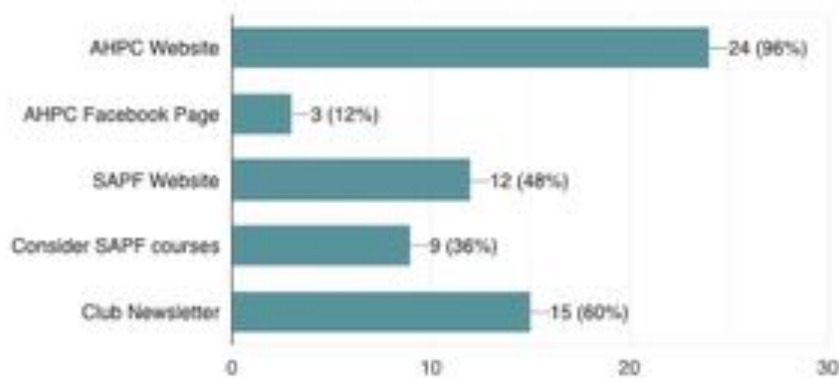
### What duration of field trips would you consider?

24 responses



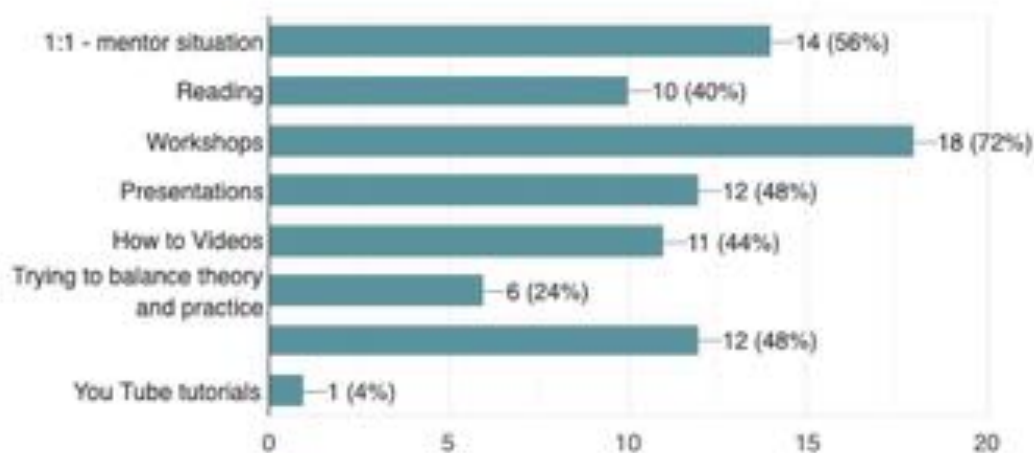
### Do you refer to any of the following for information? (Please tick any that apply)
